Note:

- 1. Match play within the round-robin portion of the tournament will be held in "pool play" fashion, with 2-25 point games. You must win by 2 and there will be no point cap.
- 2. Once the round-robin has been completed, the two teams compiling the best records throughout the 6 pool play games will play for the championship, while the other two teams will meet for 3rd place.
- 3. The 3rd place and championship matches will be best 2 out of 3 to 25 points. Again, you must win by 2 and there will be no point cap.
- 4. **TIEBREAKERS:** Should a tie of win/loss record within the pool play occur, the following procedures will be used to determine the winner:
 - a). Head to head competition with regard to wins and losses in games played between the tied teams.
 - b). Point differential between the tied teams using only the games played against one another.
 - c). Point differential of the tied teams involving <u>all</u> games played in the round-robin tournament.
 - d). Should a tie still remain, one game of 15 points will be played.
- 5. WARM-UP PROCEDURES: Each team will be allowed the normal warm-up time prior to their first match only. Thereafter, each team will be allowed 2 minutes of "shared" warm-up time followed by 4 minutes for each team. Serving time will be part of a team's 4 minutes. Practice balls will be provided.
- 6. <u>LINE JUDGES AND LIBERO TRACKERS</u>: We ask that each team provide one line judge and one libero tracker for each of their matches.
- 7. A plaque will be awarded for 1st place only. Individual medals will be awarded to the players on the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams.
- 8. Dressing rooms will be available. All valuables are the responsibility of each team.
- 9. Each team will be provided with a water cooler and cups.

- 10. We will <u>not</u> have a concession stand open to the public. Soda, juice, and snack machines will be available. Also, Subway is located across the highway from the high school. The New Haven Ice Cream shop is located just up hwy. 100 and serves a variety of food. Teams will be allowed to bring their own food and drinks, but please keep it out of the gym.
- 11. A hospitality room with sandwiches, chips, and drinks will be available to all coaches, administrators, officials, and bus drivers.
